

# CITY'S POPULATION IS 151,958

The official estimate of the population of Winnipeg, as made up from the city assessment rolls by the board of valuation and revision to Dec. 31 last, is 151,958, showing an increase over the figures of a year ago, 132,720, of approximately 20,000.

The board finds that the rateable realty assessment for the current year, confirmed, amounts to a total of \$172,677,250, of which \$118,407,650 is on land at a full money valuation, and \$54,269,600 on buildings, on a two-thirds basis.

Last year the total rateable assessment was \$157,608,220. Of this \$108,674,-  
69 was on land. The comparison shows an increase in land values in the city  
of ten million dollars.

## Exempt Property.

Exempt property is this year valued at \$27,511,350, which, when added to the rateable total, makes a total realty valuation in the city for the year 1911 of \$200,188,000. Last year the grand total was \$185,870,140.

The official report of the board of valuation came before the board of control yesterday, and was filed without comment of any kind. The business assessment is now being compiled, and a full report will be available as usual within a short time.
