## 4,490,902 GALLONS

Figures for Average Amount Pumped Daily From City Wells in February.

The official report of water pumped from the city wells in February was issued Saturday. It shows that the daily average amount of water pumped from the three wells during February was 4,490,902 gallons per 24 hours.

Following is a statement showing the average daily amount pumped from each well:

Well.	Amount per 24 hour day.
No. 2 .....	3,034,753 gal.
No. 3 .....	493,452 gal.
No. 4 .....	902,696 gal.
